PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT BOARD MEETINGS

BDDH

To be eligible to address the board, an individual should reside within M.S.A.D. #30, be an employee of M.S.A.D. #30, or be invited by the board or Superintendent of schools. They shall identify themselves in each case.

Public comment at meetings of the board can be separated into delegations or representations and brief comments on an agenda topic.

The board, at the discretion of the chairperson, may permit brief comments from the audience on agenda items prior to board action.

Delegations and prolonged representations on items not on the agenda must be directed to the superintendent of schools or chairperson one week prior to the regular meeting date for presentation to the board.

Except in an emergency, the board will not attempt to decide upon any question before full examination and an opportunity for the superintendent to research the matter and make his/her recommendation to the board.
